Aviation Security Information Circular

1. PURPOSE

- This AIC cancels AIC 07/17 dated 11 August 2017
- The purpose of this circular is to notify the aviation security stakeholders about the latest developments in the aviation security regulatory framework.

2. FOCUS

- The focal point is on the dissemination of the National Civil Aviation Security Training Programme (NCASTP), National Civil Aviation Screeners Certification Programme (NCASCP) and the National Civil Aviation Security Quality Control Programme (NCASQCP) to the aviation participants responsible for the implementation of aviation security training and certification requirements.

3. BACKGROUND

- The NCASTP and NCASCP are developed pursuant to section 118 (d), (i) and (p) of the Civil Aviation Act of 2016; whereas, the NCASQCP is developed in terms of section 118 (o) of the Act;
- Furthermore, the NCASTP and NCASCP have been developed in order to meet the obligations of Namibia in terms of Standards 3.1.6 and 3.1.7 of Annex 17 to the Chicago Convention;
- The National Civil Aviation Security Training Programme is intended to set aviation security training standards for all aviation security personnel implementing aviation security controls to ensure effective implementation of the requirements of the National Civil Aviation Security Programme;
- The primary objective of the NCASTP is to provide a frame-work for the selection, recruitment and training of staff involved in aviation security by stipulating the various responsibilities for guaranteeing this all-important activity;
- Whereas, the NCASCP aim to outline the process for conducting formal evaluations and confirmation, by or on behalf of the NCAA, to ensure that a person possesses the necessary competencies to perform assigned functions to an acceptable level as defined by the NCAA.

4. ACTION REQUIRED

- 4.1 Aviation participants responsible for the implementation of the National Civil Aviation Security Programme are urged to collect a copy of the NCASTP and NCASCP.
- 4.2 The copies of the NCASTP, NCASCP and NCASQCP will be made available at the Aviation Security Section of the NCAA at Eros Airport, Aviation Road.
