Aviation Security Information Circular

PURPOSE

- The purpose of this circular is to notify the aviation security stakeholders about the new requirements prescribed in the recently approved National Civil Aviation Security Training Programme (NCASTP), National Civil Aviation Security Screener Certification Programme (NCASSCP) and the National Civil Aviation Security Quality Control Programme (NCASQCP).
- To inform the stakeholders that the relevant parts of the NCASTP, NCASSCP and the NCASQCP will be disseminated to them by the Aviation Security Subdivision within the DCA.
- To urge all stakeholders to acquaint themselves with the content of these documents in order to meet the national requirements.

FOCUS

- The focal point is on the persons implementing various aspects of the national civil aviation security programme that they should possess all competencies required to perform their duties and that they are appropriately trained and certified according to the national requirements.
- Secondly, the determination of compliance with and validating the effectiveness of the national civil aviation security programme through oversight activities is central to the efforts of enhancing aviation security. Thus, this will promote internal quality control activities of stakeholders.

BACKGROUND

- The NCASTP, NCASQCP are developed pursuant to Parts 4.5.3, 9.6.2, 11.1 read with 11.3 of the National Civil Aviation Security Programme (NCASP).
- In addition, these documents (NCASTP, NCASQCP) are established in order to ensure compliance with Standards and Recommended Practices of Annex 17 to the Chicago Convention on International Civil Aviation, as well as the implementation of the undertaking number 8 of the Windhoek Declaration on Aviation Security and Facilitation in Africa.

INFORMATION FOR STAKEHOLDERS

The relevant parts of the NCASTP, NCASSCP and NCASQCP will be made available for collection to the stakeholders on the need to know basis.

The stakeholders should acquaint themselves with the requirements prescribed in these documents where the content of such document is disclosed.
